******Paraquat 3SL... the "3 Lb-per-Ga.-A.I."** Paraquat. Use 1 Qt-Ac-
minimum.... This kinda Weather the target will be Brown in the Morning.
If you have *all the right stuff* in your Weed-Spray-Tank-Mix, 1 Qt-Ac-will
be just fine.

If you are stuck with some Gramoxone-2L use 3-4 Pints.... more if in
cool-wet-Weather.
