Reminder...Your PHI on AgriMek/Abamectin is 4 Weeks...28 Days...You're allowed **2 - 20 oz--Applns--Season.**

**** **On-Going-Discussion....Yes...**I still maintain that Spraying reeeaaally Early...like 1am...til 9 or 10 am...makes Huuuge sense. Whenever you can avoid the *Reeeaaally Strong SunShine...???...* I'd avoid it.

+++Related: The Huuuge Row-Crop-Guys in the Grain-States told me a few Years Ago....that their Round-Up-Applns made Early Early really early Mornings work 3 - 4 times better than the Appln made at 4pm. 😞
