more than 1 Lb.[16 oz]-Acre NAA **Refine 3.5WSG**... Doing a Tank-Mix on Honeys about 7-10-Da. before Harvest with 1/3-Pouch

ReTain plus 10 oz **Refine 3.2WSG** per-Acre gets Good Reviews.

should go on 28-35-Da. before guesstimated-Harvest-Date. ReTain Apps made 28 - 35 Da. or more before anticipated Harvest won't

receally seriously impress you for Fruit-Drop control and Fruit

Process-Blocks...Not a 'Fruit-Color'-Issue... But for Fresh-Pack... remember the ReTain will cause a Color-Drag 99% of the time. Do your DiKaP and Blush 2X with your ReTain.
